Background information from DC Simon Telford

The victim Zahid was watching a boxing match last night with the deceased, Sheku Bayoh. They apparently had a few drinks of alcohol. They had an argument and Zahid parted company with Mr Bayoh, however he later returned to Mr Bayoh's house. At that point Zahid Saeed reported that Mr Bayoh attacked him and hit him over the head about 5 times. He ran away but was chased and Mr Bayoh hit him with a whirly-gig outside in the garden. Zahid Saeed went to the A&E in Kirkcaldy at midday for a review.

Examination

Examination commenced at 18:30 hours. Zahid Saeed was causally dressed and was fully cooperative but slightly apprehensive. He engaged in poor eye contact, his speech was normal but quiet. He was orientated in time, place and person.

A full body surface examination was conducted and the following *injuries* were noted:

1. Right maxilla 2cm swelling, tender on palpation, normal colour.
2. Top lip internal 1cm laceration on vertical plane, right of frenulum.
3. Occipital area on right side on the upper section with the border of the parietal border of the skull a 2cm area of tender swelling, skin intact.
4. Right post-auricular area swelling approximately 2cm, skin intact, no erythema. Tender on palpation.
5. Left hand dorsal aspect a 4cm linear abrasion in the vertical plane 3cm superior to the third posterior metacarpophalangeal joint.
6. Left leg a 3cm x 2cm bruise, circular in shape and red in colour, in the lateral condyle of the femur.

Opinion

A bruise is caused by blunt force trauma such as a knock, blow or pressure on the skin. It will change colour over a passage of time. It can cause swelling. There was evidence of swelling and tenderness in this gentleman's scalp which are not showing signs of bruising as yet but obviously this could change over time.

Similarly the swollen area on his face (the maxilla area) may well change and become more discoloured over a period of time and develop into an obvious bruise as the day's progress. Again this is consistent with trauma. I informed DS Telford of my findings.

Samples

The following forensic samples were taken at the request of CID.

- Nail scrapes right hand wet & dry
- Nail scrapes left hand wet & dry
- Right hand/finger swabs wet & dry
- Left hand/finger swabs wet & dry

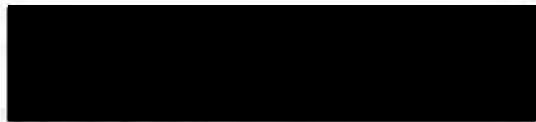


All samples were labelled, sealed in evidential bag, witnessed and handed to DC Simon Telford.



Management

- I advised this gentleman that his physical injuries would heal and that he should take simple analgesia for pain.
- Police will decide whether or not photographs should be taken.
- Police investigation continues.
