States:

I don't remember the date this happened but I remember that it was a Sunday morning and I was coming from the house ██████████, past the petrol station, I'm not sure of the road, maybe Henderson Road, and then through a mini roundabout and then another mini roundabout when I saw it.

██████████ on a Sunday at 8 so I would have left the house between quarter past and half past 7 and I was driving a white van.

When I got to the second mini roundabout I saw that there was a police van parked on the left hand side of the street. I don't remember the name of that street but it's the street that goes towards the hospital.

There was a car sitting on the roundabout blocking my way. It had stopped right on the roundabout, right in the middle. It was an Astra or some vehicle like that, I can't remember the colour, I think it was silver or black.

I noticed that on the opposite side from the police van there was these two police officers and they had a man facing down. They were pinning him down. I couldn't see the man, I was just assuming it was a man because it was two of them holding him down and you wouldn't think it would take two to hold down a woman.

I wasn't that far away from them, maybe 100 or 200 yards. I had a clear view. His feet were facing the road and his head was towards the pavement. They had him pinned down with their knees on him. I could only see the back of one of the police officers. They were using their hands and each had one knee on the top half of his body.

There was a woman police officer who was crossing the road. She was walking towards the van or one of the police vehicles. She was crossing the road towards the vehicles anyway. There was two police vehicles.

I was watching this for about a minute or so, no more than that. The car in front was still blocking my way so eventually I indicated and drove over the mini roundabout to get past them. I can't describe the people in the car other than to say that there was two of them.

Other than the police, there was another person standing on the pavement, it looked like he was one of the people from one of the houses. He was on the opposite side from the police vehicles, on the same side where the incident was taking place. He was watching it from the opposite side from the car that was stopped in front of me.

I didn't see any resistance or struggle from the man on the ground and I didn't see the police using any batons. For all the time I was passing by, that was all that I seen.

I couldn't identify the police officers again. They just had their black jackets on. I couldn't describe their build and I couldn't hear anything being said.

As I was leaving there was another police car coming from Wilson Avenue way and then later I saw another police car coming from the old Forth Park hospital way. I remember thinking that was a lot for one guy because there was already two police cars there and there was another two going.

I saw what had happened on the news and who it was and I can't remember if they contacted me about this or I contacted them. I'd seen Sheku Bayoh about but personally I didn't know him.
