I live at the above address with my [REDACTED] dad, [REDACTED] Harry Kolberg. I have lived here all my life. [REDACTED]

On Saturday night (02/05/2015) I was at [REDACTED]. We were watching the boxing until about twenty to seven on the Sunday morning when I phoned my dad to give me a run home. My dad came for me about 7 o'clock in the morning. My dad (Harry) has already given a statement to Police Scotland officers. I can't remember the exact time it was around late afternoon/early evening. I have just checked my phone and they phoned me at half past eight and they came shortly after that to speak to him. They were unable to take my statement at that time but told me they would come back tomorrow but they haven't been yet.

About 3 or 4 minutes after my dad had picked me up I noticed a guy about 30 metres ahead of us, he was walking towards the road. I would describe him as a black male, about 6", quite big, looked as though he went to the gym a lot. He was wearing a white t-shirt and jeans. I didn't notice what footwear he was wearing. I can't remember what road we were driving on when I seen him, I'm not familiar with the names of the road in the area but I know it's about 30 metres from the Shell garage where I buy my petrol. As we approached him I could clearly see he was carrying a knife in his right hand. The knife looked as though it was about 6-8 inches long, one side was curved and the other was straight. It looked like the kind of knife you would see in a kitchen. He then stepped quickly out towards our car just as the front of the vehicle had passed him. He swung his right arm hitting the rear quarter of the car. I don't know if it was his fist or the knife that hit the car but I heard a thump. At this point my dad showed slowed down the car but I told him to keep driving as I seen the guy had a knife. As my dad began to accelerate away from him up towards the Shell garage I could see the guy jogging after us. We drove to the Shell garage and stopped so my dad could phone the police. I should have said that it was me who dialled the police number and asked for the police. I told the police operator that there was a six foot black male with a knife, she then asked me what the location was so I put the phone on speaker so my dad could speak to her and tell her where it was. While my dad was speaking to her I got out the car to check it for any damage. I couldn't see any damage except for a scratch which was roughly 4 inches on the nearside rear passenger window. My dad could not say for definite if this had been caused during this incident.

Due to the bend in the road the guy was no longer visible to us so we assumed he started walking the other way. I then got back in the car and my dad decided to drive back on our original route which would take us along the road I now know to be Hayfield Road. Just before we turned left into Hayfield Road I could see the guy standing on the pavement about 30 metres past the bus stop on the left hand side. By the time we turned into Hayfield Road he was standing in the middle of the road blocking traffic. I couldn't see the knife at this point and can't say for definite if he had it or not. My dad pulled the car into the bus stop, it was at this point I started to film him on my iPhone 6. I thought the footage may help in case anything happened. At this point the guy started walking towards us on the right hand pavement and was walking behind parked cars. I told my dad to do a u-turn because I wanted to avoid him so we drove off back along Hayfield Road. I stopped filming him when I got to the roundabout and could no longer see him. We then drove home to [REDACTED] via another route and I didn't see him again.

Later that day [REDACTED] showed me a news article on [REDACTED] phone about a police woman being hurt in the Kirkcaldy area and a man wielding a knife. I didn't read the full article. Later that night, as I have previously said, the police phoned me and then came to the house but didn't have time to take a statement.

The PIRC Investigators have asked me today to confirm the details of my dad's car. My dad drives a black Peugeot 107 and the registration number is [REDACTED]. PIRC Investigator Kevin Rooney asked me if I could provide a copy of the footage I recorded in my phone, which I did via my dad's computer. I put the video download

onto his pen drive. I also agreed with him that I would retain the original footage on my phone and not share it publically.

I've also been asked if I know the male which I do not and I would not recognise him again. I don't think I would be able to identify the knife either. I can confirm this is a true and accurate record.
