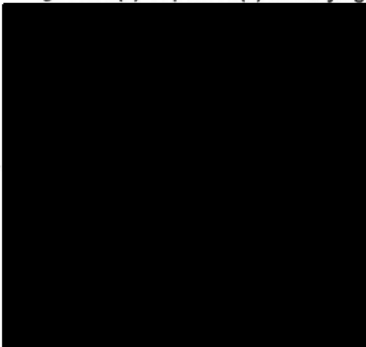

CH –	Police, what's the address of your emergency?
CB –	It's Collette Bell's address at Arran Crescent
CH –	What's happening there?
CB –	Em, I'm not sure where to start. Em, I received a phone call from my boyfriend's best friend saying that em that he's beaten him up like really really bad and that em he's scared for his safety and I've gone home and my back door's wide open and my kitchen's trashed and all my boyfriend's stuff like his jacket and his phones in the house and he's missing. I don't I mean his best friend's like worried in case he's going to hurt somebody else.
CH –	So your boyfriend's beat up his friend?
CB –	Yeah, but it's totally out of character for him.
CH –	Right what's your boyfriend's name?
CB –	It's Sheku Bayoh.
CH –	How do you spell that?
CB –	S.H.E.K.U.
CH –	S.H.E.
CB –	K.U.
CH –	K.U and how do you spell his surname?
CB –	B.A.Y.O.H.
CH –	Right, what's your name?
CB –	It's Collette Bell.
CH –	Collette Bell.
CB –	Yeah, it's cos my house like was wide open, like my back door was wide open.
CH –	And is that double A.R.O.N. is that how you spell Aaron?
CB –	A. double R.A.N. yeah.
CH –	Arran Crescent.
CB –	Yeah.
CH –	And that's in Kirkcaldy?
CB –	Yeah.

CH –	So your house is totally trashed?
CB –	Yeah and he's left his keys in the door and his jacket's there and his phone's in the kitchen, he's out with no phone and no jacket or anything on and he's obviously left the house wide open.
CH –	And you've had a phone call from his friend to say he's been beaten up?
CB –	Yeah and he's like asked me not to be in the house because he's worried about my safety. I'm worried, I'm worried about his safety but I'm also worried about the safety of others.
CH –	And all his jacket and keys and everything are there?
CB –	Yeah, I've left the house just now.
CH –	Em, when did you last see him?
CB –	Well ah stayed at my mums last night so I've not seen him since yesterday but his best friend seen him about I think it happened about an hour and maybe twenty minutes ago.
CH –	And where did this take place?
CB –	Em, his friend said that em that Shek had like chased him out of the house.
CH –	Whereabouts?
CB –	I'm not sure.
CH –	Where did they go, somewhere in Kirkcaldy?
CB –	Yeah, he's been up all night drinking so I just don't know about his state of mind at all.
CH –	Can you give me a description of him?
CB –	Em, he's about.
CH –	Is he white, is he white?
CB –	No he's black.
CH –	Uh huh.
CB –	Em shaven head, em brown eyes, he quite muscly em he's about five, like just under six foot.
CH –	Uh huh, what was he wearing do you know?
CB –	I don't have a clue.
CH –	Did he have any weapons?

CB –	Before I seen him he was wearing black jeans and a black and blue shirt em he did have a blue hoody on but I think he's probably I think that was on the floor as well. He might just have his shirt on.
CH –	He wouldn't have that on?
CB –	No, but I don't know if he's gone home and changed since I've last seen him.
CH –	B-a-y-o-h and it's S-h-e-k-u, what's his date of birth?
CB –	Eh, it's 31, it's 31st of September 1987, no 83 sorry.
CH –	Right, are you outside your property?
CB –	Em, I'm a few streets away from it.
CH –	Right, if you go back to the property we'll get someone to attend there ok.
CB –	Em well, I've left my son with my mum [REDACTED].
CH –	It's just that we'll have to get somebody to the house.
CB –	Yeh, em would it be alright if they come in about half an hour, if I just go and get my mother and my son and then go back again.
CH –	Yeah, I'll put that on it, yep.
CB –	It's just my son's breastfed and he's going to need fed.
CH –	Oh right I see, not a problem if you go and get your son and go back and we'll get officers to meet you at the address.
CB –	Ok thank you.
CH –	Right, thanks, bye.
CB –	Bye.
