Suspect is cold but this has little effect and he laughs. Suspect struck with baton at least once. A number of police officers attended the bar. Suspect was unconscious on the ground. CPR done by police and then by paramedics short time later.

Male is at A&E at Kirkcaldy Royal Infirmary. Original scene seen by police. Possible CCTV coverage. About 0800 more female reports have emerged and a male missing. Police attending the report. Unsure if knife has been recovered.

Summary of Circumstances

- 0714 Call from named reporter re African man in Mercury Road, Kirkcaldy. The male is chasing cogs with a knife.
- 0715 Second reporter states male is jumping out in front of cogs.
- 0715 Reporter states male with knife Hayfield Road.
- 3 marked police vehicles and 1 unmarked car responded. Male appears in front of them. He runs towards them with knife. Batons pulled out and CS deployed. Initial reports are that CS does not take effect. Officers strike man with batons. The male punches female on side of head. He is subdued and taken to the ground, head cuffed and leg restraints used. During struggle male becomes unconscious. Ambulance arrives 0730 hours. Male is not breathing and CPR given by officers.
- 0732 Ambulance arrives and crew take on CPR.
- 0738 Male taken into ambulance and taken to Kirkcaldy Royal Infirmary.
- 0904 Life pronounced extinct. Body moved from resuscitation room to side room of A&E.

About 0300 hrs incident at Martin Dick's

Mose [redacted] took deceased to his car house where it is alleged he assaulted Zahid Saad. Deceased was wearing a white T shirt. No Jacket and carrying a 9" blade.

Alert to Mose will be coordinated and will be run by PRC on completion. 3600 camera footage of incident being run carried out by Road Camera Investigators, Mayfield Road.

Police station was was agreed to get photographs taken of injury to head, which will be reported tomorrow. At a request PAVA will be negated.

Next of kin, sister has been informed of death.

Press release

"Following an incident this morning in the Mayfield Road area of Kircaldy officers from Police Scotland had been attempting to arrest him during which time he has become unconscious. He was conveyed to hospital by SAS. Despite best efforts by hospital staff he died after 9.00 on this morning.

1950 meeting with Police Scotland, Senior Managerial, chaired by Ruriah Nicolson. Update from SIO new deceased has blood in nose. A female witness near locus joined incident on iPhone which is believed to show deceased on ground in leg restraints. Phone taken for examination and will be fast tracked.

Adi brother in law. Faith Rye rep. reports unruly groups. Ch Supt McEwen reports highly charged atmosphere at the house. Not happy with disclosure of information by police. Family think relative murdered. Have distrust of local officers.

Update from Ch Supt McEwen.

During his visit to family he told them about incident, male with knife who was CSd & bated by officers during course of arrest of new deceased. He became unconscious and ambulance summoned. Door to door enquires. PRC have been notified and in attendance. Independent investigation clothing taken from officers. Kadli taking

notes during discussion meeting was at

[REDACTED]

2140 Called Adil Somani back at home address. He has still not returned.

2210 Attended at home address at [REDACTED] with Alex McBride and met with family. In house were Adil and Roshan Somani and approx 16-18 other people. Adil confirmed he had been elected as family spokesperson. The family appeared clearly upset and angry. Adil stated that they were angry and frustrated by the differing and conflicting information provided by Bute Scotland offices and he intended to make a complaint re their brief overview of this process given and the request to make complaint to Bute Scotland direct. They were advised of the PIR review and function. I outlined this would be a fully independent and thorough enquiry conducted by experienced investigators. I also outlined the arrangements in place for the Post Mortem on 4 May 2015 at Edinburgh. Adil indicated the family had discussed matters and no representatives were willing to do the identification with family members, including now deceased mother and [REDACTED]

She was travelling with a group, including elders from England. Adil also indicated that he intended to go to the Media and consult with local community regarding these issues.

0700 Call to D/Supt Pat Campbell. He confirms Bute Scotland collecting medical records for Post Mortem. Arrangements in place to photograph ambulance which is still off scene. Contact number for Colette Bell [REDACTED]

0730 Confirmation from Pat Campbell now deceased particularly Ahmed Tejan Bayon. He also indicated that vehicle used by witness Harry Caldwell has brief CCTV images of now deceased in street.

D/Supt Campbell believes that 4
detective officers unbracketed with
family and Ch Supt McEwan. He will
provide details. He was asked to
provide details of Hesse to Hesse
Coordinator.

0940 Pat Campbell no resources

Collette Bell's address at Arran Crescent

1600 Update from D/Supt Pat Campbell that
tablets of some description had been
in possession of now deceased at
Arran Crescent. Phone then passed to
Ade Nicolson. He provided information
suggesting PLO's were wanted by family
at home address. This was passed to him
by Chief Spt McEwan who had earlier
attended at the house. I informed me I
was not aware Police Scotland were
attending the house. Informed him my
understanding was that our PLOs had names
in hand and one communicating with
the family through an appointed solicitor
we will make further enquiry to Chief
Alistair Lewis updated of new
information
